From Director Annette Taylor

Welcome to a new school year! We're off to a good start with 49 students, but we still have room for more friends, especially in the pre-kindergarten classes and the older threes. Help spread the word!

Thank you to all families who were able to come to our Back-to-School night. It was great to see everyone and have the opportunity to review key policies and introduce the staff, including teachers and pastors here at Peace Lutheran Church. If you were unable to attend, be sure to ask for a school calendar that goes through the school year. It includes important scheduled events and closure dates.

I'm looking forward to an awesome year! Remember you are always welcome to participate as able. I would appreciate you contacting me with any concerns that may arise. We want preschool to be an excellent experience — not only for your child, but for the entire family.

On a personal note, those of you who have been here a while know that I was diagnosed with stage-4 kidney cancer in March, and I am taking an oral chemo-therapy drug. I want you to know that through the grace of God, I am doing well! I have been blessed to have had only minimal side-effects. At the end of the first three-month round of chemo I had a scan that showed the cancer had reduced in size by between thirty and fifty percent! (The cancer in my kidney is gone because the kidney was removed; but I have several spots in my lungs of various sizes.) I am so thankful to God for this miraculous reduction! I so appreciate your prayers, love and concern. I am hopeful that I will have continued success with my treatment with our Lord and Savior making it happen.

Parent Tip of the Month:

When children misbehave: redirect, redirect, redirect.



Kids who hear “No” or “Don’t” all the time tend to tune out those directives. So instead of telling your child what *not to do*, offer a positive behavior to replace the misbehavior. For instance, a child acting up in the grocery store could be enlisted to help pick out oranges or rearrange the items in the grocery cart.

Another suggestion is to offer your child two choices for what they CAN do. By doing this you are allowing them some control/power over a situation. For example, if your child does not want to stop what they are doing to go take a bath, you can offer two choices: “Would you like to read a story book now, before you take a bath, or would you rather read the story book after you take a bath? You choose.”
