Classrooms 2 & 3 graduating students will be participating in our graduation program on Sunday, June 2 during the 10 am church service.


Included in the ceremony:

Parent Tip of the Month



TAKING TURNS

Taking turns and waiting for something you really want is not a natural human response and is not an easy thing to do, even for adults! So just imagine how difficult it might be for a preschooler. Learning how to take turns requires a lot of practice.

I encourage you to find many opportunities to practice this important skill with your child. Here are some ideas:

1. When playing, whether its building, kicking a ball, sliding down a slide, or playing with playdough, you can use the words: "You can have a turn first, then it will be my turn."
2. When deciding on an activity: "You can choose what game we play first today ,then it will be my turn to choose."

Waiting for a turn can be very difficult, but it is an important skill and it should be practiced often. Here is one way to give it a try: Choose a toy that your child especially enjoys and take turns playing with it for short periods of time. Again using the words: "It's my turn now, then it will be your turn."

Be sure to praise your child when he/she is being patient and waiting for a turn, remembering to use the words "taking turns".


